## Summary

Howlong Public School is working hard to support the social and emotional wellbeing of the students, staff and families in the school community. It is imperative that each child feels safe and supported and has a sense of belonging. From this connected community, students have the potential to thrive.

Our School Chaplain, Col Sharrock has been providing programs and supporting the wellbeing of the school community since 2016. We have recently been given the opportunity to extend the chaplaincy program through the Student Wellbeing Support Program and to ensure this takes place \$7000 community funding needs to be raised each year for the next three years. The school and the State Government will match this amount, equating to an extra 10 hours of student well-being support.

## Generate School Chaplains

Generate School Chaplains are majority funded through the National Schools Chaplaincy Programme as well as local school and community funding.

School Chaplains are required to have as a minimum of a Certificate IV in Youth Work or Pastoral Care (or designated equivalent).

Our School Chaplain runs many programs specifically tailored to meet the needs of students and the school community across the year levels.

Program sessions cover topical areas such as

- Anxiety
- How to be Assertive
- Anger Management
- Emotional and Social Awareness
- Friendship Skills
- Leadership
- Resilience
- Self Esteem
- Team Building/Problem Solving

One off sessions are also offered to address the specific needs of individual students as required.

Some of these areas include

- Grieving
- Family Issues
- Family Illness
- Friendship
- Conflict

The programs not only help students to understand the impact in these areas of their lives, but they also equip the students in being better able to deal with issues in these areas of their lives.

The programs enhance their sense of self, connectedness to the community and provide development of interpersonal skills for lifelong learning.

All of which instil greater confidence in the students which will have on going positive impact for the students, school and greater community.

The Chaplains role has an overall positive impact on the school community. Whether running sessions with groups, having one on one chats, or just wandering the playground being available as a mentor.
